

# UCI'S ORAL PROFICIENCY TESTING FOR INTERNATIONAL GRADUATE STUDENTS

## MINIMUM TEST SCORES TO BE A TEACHING ASSISTANT

International students are required to have one of these minimum scores in order to be a Teaching Assistant:

- 26 on the speaking part of TOEFL iBT (<http://www.ets.org/toefl>)
- 8 on the speaking part of IELTS (<http://www.ielts.org>)
- 50 on UCI's SPEAK (<http://www.humanities.uci.edu/studio/speak/>)
- 5 on UCI's TOEP (<http://www.humanities.uci.edu/esl/toep/>)

## TEST ELIGIBILITY

All UCI graduate students who have taken IELTS or TOEFL iBT and have the scores in their UCI StudentAccess profile (or can provide a score report) are eligible to take TOEP. Students who do not have one of these scores must take UCI's SPEAK and receive a score of 40 or above to be eligible to take TOEP ONE time. Only those students who receive a score of 4 on TOEP are eligible to RETAKE it without passing an AcEng oral communications course. Students who receive a score of 40 or below on a second SPEAK or a score of 1, 2, or 3 on TOEP will not be eligible to take SPEAK or TOEP until they have passed an AcEng oral communications course.

**NOTE:** Students can only take TOEP 5 times. After the 4th test, students must confer with the TOEP coordinator to decide when the last and final test should be taken.
