Call for Proposals

Individual and Collaborative Research Projects
2009-10

The International Center for Writing and Translation (ICWT) is now accepting proposals for UCI Faculty Associate Grants, for individual and collaborative research projects. All UCI faculty are eligible to apply (including adjunct professors and lecturers who are employed by UCI for the period in which the award will be used).

Proposals for projects in the following areas are eligible:

**Cultural Literacies
Transculturation**

**Cultural Transposition
Translation**

**Diaspora
Language-Preservation and Revival**

Grants are awarded on a competitive basis and the maximum funding level is \$500. Funds must be used by October 31, 2010.

Proposals may include requests for support in the following areas:

Individual Projects: airfare, lodging, ground transportation, photocopying fees, library fees, books specific to this project, research assistance, translation assistance, manuscript preparation and publication subsidies.

Collaborative Projects: airfare, lodging, ground transportation, honoraria, catering, research assistance, manuscript preparation and publication subsidies.

Please Note: unacceptable expenses include the purchase of computer software/hardware, other electronic or audio-visual equipment, and personal items.

Applications should include:

- Cover sheet (available at the ICWT office or website)
- For individual projects: proposer's one-page resume
- For collaborative projects: list of participants' names, with one-page resumes
- Narrative description of project (1,000 words maximum)
- **Itemized** budget *with justification* and schedule of expenditures (this is an important basis for awarding funding). If hiring research assistants, please include detailed description of work to be performed and explanation of hourly rate of pay
- Project funding summary
