

## Call for Nominations Graduate Student Fellowships 2023-2024

Nominations due Wednesday, March 1, 2023

The Center for Critical Korean Studies (CCKS) announces two graduate fellowships for the 2023-2024 academic year. Each fellowship will include a \$25,000 stipend fund by a grant from the Academy for Korean Studies, with in-state tuition, fees, and health insurance provided by the student's home school. The recipient will be expected to participate in CCKS events and scholarly activities.

### <u>Eligibility</u>

Students with a research focus on Korea and enrolled in a PhD program in a department or program in the UCI School of Humanities or School of Social Sciences are eligible to be nominated. Priority will be given to incoming students who are among the top-ranked admits in their department. **Each department in Humanities and Social Sciences may nominate up to three students for a fellowship in 2023-2024.** 

### **Nominations**

Submit a nomination packet for up to three students per department containing the graduate student's application materials including: academic transcripts, letters of recommendation, writing sample, and other supplemental materials, with a cover letter explaining why the department ranked the student highly for admission.

### Selection Process:

A CCKS committee will review the nominations and determine the recipient for the 2023-2024 fellowship. CCKS will notify the awardees' department and the Offices of Graduate Studies by **Friday, March 17, 2023**.
