## *B.A. in Spanish: Emphasis in Literature & Culture*

### Prerequisite for Spanish 3A and 3B

An active prerequisite check system is in place for Spanish 3A and 3B. In order to enroll in the Spanish 3 series, a student must have passed Spanish 2C, S2BC or 2NS (native speakers), or scored 110 or above on the Spanish Placement Test.

You may take 3A and 3B concurrently. You must, however, complete both 3A and 3B before taking Spanish 15 or upper-division SPAN courses.
