

# Spanish Placement Table

1. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... without previous background ...	... take a copy of their <b>high school transcript</b> to the Humanities Undergraduate Counseling Office in 143 Humanities Instructional Building (HIB). ...	... activate their <b>eligibility</b> to enroll in Spanish 1A

2. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... with previous high school background ...	... take the <b>Placement Test</b> ...	... enroll in the appropriate course as indicated by the <b>Placement Test</b>

3. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... with a previous course (or courses) from another college or university ...	... take a copy of their <b>college transcripts</b> to the Humanities Undergraduate Counseling Office in 143 Humanities Instructional Building (HIB). ...	... receive <b>authorization</b> to enroll in the next course

4. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... who scored a 100 or above on the <b>Placement Test</b> , AND who graduated from a High School in a Spanish-speaking country, or a Spanish Academy ...	... may be <b>exempt</b> from taking a lower-division Spanish language class altogether. For more info, please contact the Spanish Language Curriculum Director, Prof. J. Kempff, at JKEMPPF@UCI.EDU for a <b>personal placement interview</b> ...	... <b>determine</b> the level in which they should enroll

5. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... who have already met the UCI General Education requirement for graduation with SAT Subject Test scores, International Baccalaureate (IB) scores, or Advanced Placement (AP) examinations ...	... take the <b>Placement Test</b> ...	... enroll in the appropriate course as indicated by the <b>Placement Test</b>  <b>NOTE:</b> Students cannot earn units or grade points at UCI in courses from which they have been exempted on the basis of IB or AP credit, even if the placement test result recommends enrollment in such a level

6. STUDENTS ...	ACTION TO BE TAKEN	IN ORDER TO
... currently enrolled in any 1A through 2B course at UCI ...	... receive a " <b>C</b> " or better ...	... <b>enroll for the next course</b> within the series without having to take the placement test

**NOTE:** Native or near-native speakers who place into Spanish 2C are encouraged to enroll in Spanish 2NS, Spanish for Native Speakers, instead.
