Education Abroad Option:

A maximum of six upper-division courses taken during study abroad may be counted toward the major requirement. All such courses taken abroad must be approved by the Undergraduate Director of the Department of German, and students are advised to consult with the Undergraduate Director both prior to and after their stay abroad. Course approval typically involves the following:

- 1) presentation of syllabi and other pertinent course materials (term papers, exams, etc.)
- 2) approval by the German Undergraduate director and the Humanities Office of Undergraduate Study

In planning their undergraduate career, all students should keep in mind the Residency Requirement, which stipulates that at least six upper-division courses required for the major must be completed successfully at UCI.
