His first novel, written in French, was *Soupir de l'Ange*. His second novel, *Ma part d'elle*, was published in 2017 and translated into English as "*My Part of Her*". Javad Djavahery will discuss his experience as a refugee in France, his path as a bilingual writer, and his latest novel, *Ma part d'elle*.
