Offering dynamic productions in a unique space, New Swan features professional actors and students working side-by-side to produce scintillating Shakespearean productions. The community, campus, and press have embraced New Swan and it is now a destination festival for lovers of the Bard. The New Swan Theater, our intimate, portable mini-Elizabethan theater, is unique to Orange County, and indeed to the world. OC Weekly awarded New Swan "Best Theater / Playhouse" in 2017. Our 2018 season will feature two of Shakespeare's greatest plays, *A Midsummer Night's Dream* and *The Winter's Tale*.

Internship Program Overview

The New Swan Intern Program offers opportunities to work with theater professionals in summer rep. Both productions open at the same time and rotate nightly throughout the summer. Interns learn the nuts and bolts of a professional theater operation, and can use this experience as a springboard for future employment and/or graduate school applications. Here are some of the many benefits:

- Interns may earn credit at UCI for their participation in the program.
- Ongoing seminars/classes with members of the New Swan company.
- Performance piece featuring interns in the New Swan Theater.
- Interns may also participate in the New Swan pre-show.
- Late night cabaret for all members of the New Swan company.

New Swan Internships

The following descriptions are intended to give you a sense of the various Internships opportunities that are currently available this summer. We are intent on ensuring that individual intern interests are served. Enrollment in specific areas is on a first-come, first-served basis.

Front of House

This internship focuses on welcoming audiences to the New Swan Theater, and helping ensure that the show is running smoothly. Duties include:

- Front of House set-up and strike
- Concessions pre-show and at intermission
- Ushering pre-show, intermission, and post-show
- Noise control during the performance
- Changeover between shows
- · Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

Sound

This internship focuses on sound design and playback during shows.

Duties include:

- Audio system set-up and strike
- Pre-show sound check and speaker test
- Learning and practicing cues in rehearsal
- Sound shop assistance
- Running the sound board cues during performances
- Changeover between shows
- Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

Scenic and Props

This internship focuses on the scenic designs and props that support the shows. Duties include:

- Prop construction
- Scenic assistance painting, building maintenance set-up, etc.
- Prop running and tracking during shows
- Show set-up and strike
- Ongoing shop assistance
- Changeover between shows
- Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

Costumes

This internship focuses on costume construction, maintenance, and use during shows. Duties include:

- Costume preparation sewing, ironing, steaming, mending, etc.
- Costume tracking
- Costume check in and out
- Laundry transportation from theater to shop, and shop to theater
- Ongoing shop assistance
- Changeover between shows
- Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

Lighting

This internship is focused on lighting the shows at New Swan.

Duties include:

- Helping with lighting hang and focus
- Programming assistance during technical rehearsals
- Light board operation
- System set-up and strike
- Shop assistance
- Changeover between shows
- Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

Running Crew and/or Assistant Stage Manager

This internship focuses on assisting stage management in running shows. Duties include:

- Rehearsal room support and set-up
- Script assistance and tracking the staging
- Assisting backstage with the run of the show
- Assisting in duties assigned to the Stage Manager
- Changeover between shows
- Additional tasks that keep the theater running smoothly

We may be able to create internships in two areas of interest. In addition, we may have internships available in Company Management, Directing, Publicity.
