Establishing in-state residency

There are four requirements you must fulfill in order to be a California resident for purposes of tuition at UC. All these requirements must be met by the residence determination date (generally the first day of classes) of the term for which you request a resident classification. Graduate students are required to establish in-state residency by the start of their second year.
