A specialist in early modern Spanish theater, he is the author of *Masculinidades en obras: el drama de la hombría en la España imperial* (2008) and of numerous articles on the literary and cultural production of Spain and the Americas from the late 15th through the 17th centuries. Professor Cartagena-Calderón is currently working on a book project on the intersection of homoeroticism and the sacred in early modern Spanish literature and the visual arts.
